Nike Air Max Plus Utility Men's Shoes The Nike Air Max Plus Utility Men's Shoes are a rugged, weather-ready version of the iconic Air Max Plus (Tuned Air) silhouette. Designed for durability and all-terrain performance, these shoes feature a mix of reinforced materials, enhanced traction, and the signature Max Air cushioning for comfort.
